Position Description:

This position will provide assistance with coaching/mentoring to the Ninilchik NYO Senior/Junior Teams for the 2024 – 2025 season. *Culture, enrichment, and self-esteem promotion is a focus for the team players as well as family participation at all events.*

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work with The Ninilchik NYO team Coach at four weekly practices as well as four distance events for the Native Youth Olympics.
- Promote cultural awareness /self-esteem building to the NYO team.
- Work with Ninilchik Traditional Council’s Youth Alcohol Program and Outreach staff regarding youth challenges as needed.
- Other duties as assigned by the Native Connections Program Manager, NTC Tribal Health Director and/or the NTC Executive Director and his/her designee.

Qualifications

- Valid Alaska Driver’s License, transportation, and proof of insurance.
- Minimum 18 years of age.
- High School Graduate or GED.
- Must be alcohol/substance abuse free and comply with Drug & Alcohol testing requirements.
- Must undergo and clear a background check and character investigation.
- Demonstrates knowledge and appreciation of Alaskan Native/American Indian culture.
- Demonstrates ability to act in a confidential manner in all dealings.
- Ability to communicate and work well with others.
- Willingness to travel and as job requires.
- Excellent and professional interpersonal and people skills.

INDIAN PREFERENCE:

In filling this position by initial appointment, promotion, transfer, reassignment, reinstatement, or any other personnel action, we are required by law, Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act to give absolute preference in selection to candidates who are eligible for Indian Preference. For consideration under Indian Preference, proof is required.

OTHER:

This position will be under the direct supervision of the NTC Native Connections Program Manager. All NTC positions are subject to, and under the direct authority, of the NTC Policies and Procedures. NTC is an alcohol and drug-free workplace and employees are required to abide by the drug and alcohol policies and procedures. As with all NTC positions, employment is subject to availability of funds.
